## **F3 AWARD TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- 1. Open to students of all nationalities from public, private and international schools in Malaysia.
- 2. Scholarships are applicable to all first-time applicants for 2020 intakes only.
- 3. To apply, applicants must submit a certified true copy of their latest results.
- 4. To claim the scholarship or award disbursement, applicants must complete the registration process and meet UNIMY's minimum entry requirements for the respective programme.
- 5. Recipients who applied with their latest results must submit a certified true copy of their actual results within ten (10) working days of the official release of results. Recipients who do not meet the minimum requirement in their actual results are required to refund the scholarship amount disbursed.
- 6. Quantum deduction is based on tuition fee ONLY.
- 7. Awards are limited in number and subject to availability. Applicants will be assessed according to the assessment criteria set out for each programme and award category.
- 8. Subject to fund availability and management discretion, recipients who applied with their latest results are eligible to receive a scholarship or award upgrade based on their actual results. In the event of an upgraded scholarship or award, the incremental amount will be offset against subsequent semester's fees.
- 9. Scholarships granted are neither transferrable not exchangeable for cash.
- 10. Recipients must maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.0 set by UNIMY at the end of each academic semester in order to maintain the scholarship. Recipients who do not meet the minimum CGPA are required to refund the scholarship amount disbursed.
- 11. Students are entitled to only ONE scholarship/award/waiver/bursary/other forms of financial sponsorship at any one time, including sponsorship from other institutions or bodies. The award with the highest quantum will automatically apply.
- 12. Eligible recipients will be notified in writting.
- 13. If the award is paid as a result of false information submitted, UNIMY has the right to recover any amount of award disbursed from the recipient.
- 14. UNIMY reserves the right to involve the recipients in interviews, advertisements, photography or other publicity-related activities for the purpose of promoting the institution. Recipients who fail to comply with all the terms and conditions may be required to refund the amount disbursed to him/her from UNIMY.
- 15. Recipients will be required to sign an agreement accepting the terms and conditions of the scholarship or award. Recipients who fail to comply with all the terms and conditions may be required to refund the amount disbursed to him/her from UNIMY.
- 16. Recipients are required to complete their studies with UNIMY. Should a recipient drop out before the end of the programme, he/she is required to refund the amount disbursed to him/her by UNIMY.
- 17. All scholarship recipients are required to undergo a Scholars Development Programme during the duration of their scholarship which includes exposures to various departments within UNIMY for enhanced working exposures, acting as an Ambassador of the University at various events and etc, in order to progress with their scholarship in the subsequent semesters.
- 18. The decision of UNIMY shall be final and binding in all matters pertaining to the scholarship and award.
- 19. The terms and conditions of the scholarship and award may be modified and amended from time to time as deemed reasonable and appropriate by UNIMY.
